

Nigeria Needs Leaders, Policies To Tackle Insecurity, Unemployment - Tambuwal

Hoodlums and organized transporters on Wednesday attacked the Federal Capital Territory Administration (FCTA) officials who were on duty to enforce an order at Fafe, Ojo, Lagos State, on Tuesday.
